The Pioneering Care Partnership (PCP) is a charity committed to the improvement of people's health, wellbeing and quality of life. PCP recognises that our activities, products, and services have the potential to adversely impact on the environment.

PCP runs the following services and activities within the Pioneering Care Centre:

- Health and wellbeing activities including a hydrotherapy pool and complementary therapies
- Employability support services
- Disability projects and activities
- Community courses, arts on prescription hub and adult learning opportunities
- Lifestyle & exercise classes and activities
- Health Trainer & Health Trainer Champion support services
- Conference, meeting, room hire facilities and hospitality services
- A community café
- A community garden and allotments

PCP regards environmental performance as an integral part of our operations and as such we are committed to maintaining the highest possible environmental standards in every aspect of our operations, in order to reduce PCP's impact on earth's natural systems. We currently have an Environmental Management System and Environmental Quality Standard ISO 14001.

PCP has a commitment to:

- Continually improve our environmental performance through the establishment of an environmental objectives and targets programme;
- Comply with all relevant environmental legislative and regulatory requirements and other applicable codes of practice;
- Prevent pollution as a result of our operations by identifying significant environmental aspects and implementing control measures accordingly.

- Achieving strategic aims by incorporating environmental issues into business management
- Encouraging better environmental performance of PCP's suppliers
